Designing for the Internet and Browsers

- Pages should be < 30K if possible
- Preload supporting files
- Design for version 4+ browsers
 - JavaScript 1.1
 - CSS level 1
 - CSS level 1 compliant DHTML
- Be careful with Java (security issues)
- Test everything



Keeping Students Motivated

- Provide incentives
- Apply content to real goals
- Let the student control the pace
- Offer options for advanced users
- Offer a suggested path for novices



Interacting with Students

- Tell 'em
- Show 'em
- Let 'em try it
- Offer practice in a safe environment
- Provide feedback
- Let students "talk back"



- Audience graphic artists
- Features
 - Flash-based demonstrations
 - outline links
 - prompting navigation
 - modular quizzes with encouraging feedback
- Browser support
 - HTML version 4+ browsers


